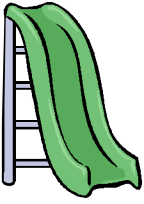


# M.O.M.S. Park Days 2009

## May 26: Perrigo Community Park

**ALT: Lake Hills Library, 10:15 & 11:00 AM, story time**

Located at 9011 196<sup>th</sup> Ave NE, Redmond. Take 520 eastbound to the end (follow the signs to Avondale Rd; far left lane), and turn right on NE Union Hill Rd (the light at the end of the freeway). Drive about one mile and turn left on 196<sup>th</sup> Ave NE. The park is less than a half-mile down 196<sup>th</sup>.

## June 2: Lewis Creek Park

**ALT: Children’s Museum, Factoria 10:00 AM, \$7**

Located at 5702 Lakemont Blvd SE, Bellevue. From I-90 East, take the Lakemont Blvd. SE exit (Exit 13), toward SE Newport Way. Turn right onto West Lake Sammamish Pkwy SE/Lakemont Blvd SE. Continue to follow Lakemont Blvd SE. The park is on your left. The playground is behind the community center.

## June 9: Kelsey Creek Park and Farm

**ALT: 3-2-1- Bounce, Bellevue, 10:45 AM, \$6**

Located at 410 130<sup>th</sup> Pl SE, Bellevue. From I-405, take the SE 8<sup>th</sup> St exit and head east. Pass under the train trestle and go straight across Lake Hills Connector. The road will wind through a residential area. Turn left at the 2<sup>nd</sup> stop sign (128<sup>th</sup> Ave SE), then right at SE 4<sup>th</sup>. Follow signs into the park. Look for us near the playground or up by the animals. Up the hill from the playground is a large barn with several outdoor enclosures full of sheep, goats, pigs, horses and cows.

## June 16: Family Picnic, Grass Lawn Park

**ALT: Chuck E. Cheese (148<sup>th</sup> Ave)**

Located at 7031 148 Ave NE, Redmond. Bring dad and dinner and come picnic with your friends from MOMS! A switch from the morning park days, let’s meet from **5:00-7:30 PM** (or whatever time works for your family!). From Westminster Chapel, drive north on 140<sup>th</sup> Ave NE. Turn right on NE 70<sup>th</sup>/Old Redmond Rd. Parking lot is on the left before you reach 148<sup>th</sup> Ave NE. Look for us at the playground area just up from this parking lot and/or the nearby picnic areas. There is shelter from rain.

## June 23: Saint Edwards State Park

**ALT: Tot Spot Café, Woodinville, [totspotcafe.com](http://totspotcafe.com)**

Located at 14445 Juanita Dr. NE, Kenmore. This park can be shady, so make sure to bring sweatshirts, etc for your kids! From I-405 northbound: Take Exit 20-A (116<sup>th</sup> St. N.E.) and turn west (left). Travel 4.5 miles (at 98<sup>th</sup> Ave., the road name changes to Juanita Dr.). Park entrance is on left. From I-405 southbound: exit at Hwy. 522 (exit #23-B). Drive through Bothell to Kenmore. Turn left at 68<sup>th</sup> Ave (68<sup>th</sup> turns into Juanita Dr.). Park is 1.5 miles on the right.

## June 30: Idylwood Park

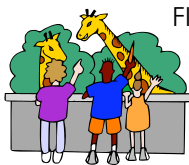
**ALT: Crossroads Comm Ctr, 9:00-11:30 AM, \$2.50**

3650 West Lk. Sammamish Pkwy NE, Redmond. This park has a great play area for toddlers and young kids to play on (newly revamped). It also has a great water area for wading and swimming. From SR-520: take NE 40<sup>th</sup> St. exit. Turn right at NE 40<sup>th</sup> St. Travel 1.2 miles. Turn right at W. Lake Sammamish Pkwy NE. Travel .3 miles to park.

### July 7: Woodland Park Zoo, Seattle

ALT: Pacific Science Center



FIELD TRIP! Located at 750 N. 50th Street (south entrance), the zoo is opens at 9:30 AM. Take I-5 north to NE 50th St (exit 169). Go west 1.3 miles to the South Gate at N 50th St and Fremont Ave N. Parking is \$5.00 per car. Admission prices are \$16.50/adult, \$11.00 for 3-12 year-olds, and 0-2 year-olds are free. For more information, check [www.zoo.org](http://www.zoo.org).

### July 14: Newcastle Beach Park

ALT: Westminster Gym

Located at 4400 Lake Washington Blvd SE, Bellevue. From I-405, take the 112th Ave SE exit and head west. Head north on Lake Washington Blvd SE and turn left into the park at the end of the road. There is a play area and the beach. Bring suits and towels for the beach, if you like.

### July 21: Pine Lake Park, Sammamish

ALT: Westminster Gym

Located at 228th Ave SE and SE 24th in Sammamish. From I-90 eastbound, take exit 15 (Lake Sammamish State Park/Hwy 900) and turn left. Stay on this street as it curves around (by Tully's), and turn left on East Lake Sammamish Pkwy. Turn right on SE 43rd, which becomes 228th Ave SE. Turn left at SE 24th into the park. Coming from Redmond, drive up to the plateau and then south on 228th Ave SE. Turn right at SE 24th into the park. There is a play area and the beach. Bring suits and towels for the beach, if you like.

### July 28: Lake Sammamish State Park, Issaquah

ALT: Westminster Gym

From I-90, take exit 15; turn left, stay to the left lane, and follow the signs to Lake Sammamish State Park. This may be one of the more challenging parks to "connect" at, so look for us at the "2nd" beach area playground and don't get discouraged too easily! Please note, the former parking charge has been removed, there is no fee! Bring suits and towels for the beach, if you like.

### August 4: Juanita Beach Park

ALT: Westminster Gym

Located at 9703 NE Juanita Dr, Kirkland. From I-405, exit at NE 116th and head west. Go straight through the light at 95th. The park is on the left. Look for us at the NEW playground. Bring dad and dinner and come picnic with your friends from MOMS! As an alternative to morning park days, let's meet from 5:00-7:30 PM (or whatever time works for your family!). Located just south of Bellevue Square Mall, take the NE 4th St exit off of I-405 (if it's open!) and head west. Turn left on 100th Ave NE. There is a parking lot off of 100th Ave or turn left at NE 1st and left into the parking lot closest to the playground area. Located at 12421 103rd Ave NE, Kirkland. From I-405, exit at NE 124th St in Kirkland and head west. The "Choo-Choo Train Park" will be on your right before you reach 100th Ave NE.

ALT: Crossroads Comm Ctr 9:00-11:30 AM, \$2.50

Located at 999-164th Ave. NE, Bellevue. Southeast of Crossroads Mall, the parking lot entrance is from 164th Ave NE just north of NE 8th St. Look for us near the play structures or in the water!
