Laurey & Patty's granddaughter, Hannah Marriott (age 5)—continue to pray for restoration of lost vision in her left eye; she's undergoing treatment with corrective lenses and an eye patch and things are improving.

The children would become wards of the state in August. Eric has taken the class and he's chosen this route to save his family. **Marlene's niece, Eric's sister, Heather, & husband, Scott**—Scott has been back in the hospital several times due to effects from the chemo. He has a staph infection at the site where the line for his chemo goes. They removed the line & put in a shunt on Tuesday (5/18). Anita Santoyo's sister, Cherrie (Update)—She's breathing much easier, has more energy, and has even taken a couple of road trips to Portland since she finished up chemo treatments about 5 weeks ago. Our God is so amazing! Last December she was on oxygen and barely able to walk up a flight of stairs. The cancer is not gone, so we do ask for continued prayer that God will guide the doctors on choosing her next round of treatment.

Linda Eames (Update)—"I am over halfway through with the radiation treatment. My finish date is June 3rd.....hooray! This radiation treatment has gone 100% better than my last course seven years ago! Praise God!!! Thank you for your continued prayers. I am, however, seeing an increase in my chronic pain on my left side (where liposarcoma resides). I will see my pain doctor soon. I'm not sure if the nerve medicine I am on is losing its potency. I've been on this for a long time. Please pray for an answer on this. I ended up in ER last Wednesday with another bout of pancreatitis. I am waiting to hear back from my GI specialist at the UW. I am really hoping in God's timing that I will be able to have an ERCP which could possibly solve this problem as it did with Sarah."

But the infection is responding to the antibiotics and he is much more alert today. Still in ICU but acting more like himself. He needs a heart valve replacement surgery, but will have to wait until the infection is totally clear. I know we serve an awesome God who is able to heal. Thank you for praying. Please keep at it!

Arlene Madrid's parents—pray for them as they are being interviewed at the U.S. Embassy in Manila sometime this evening (our time). Pray they will be granted favor in the eyes of the interviewer and that they will be calm!

Update from Sarah Eames—"I met with the Geneticist last Wednesday and I was tested for mitochondrial dysfunction which could explain why I had failure to thrive when I was a baby and when I was 13 & 14. It sounds like they are going to treat me no matter what the results show. The Dr. says there are hundreds of these, and that if the treatment works, I most likely have it, and they will investigate further. He also said I have trouble digesting carbs and he wants me to limit my carbs, and increase my fats and proteins. I will be meeting with a nutritionist next time. Mitochondrial dysfunction is very rare. The treatment for it is high doses of vitamin C, vitamin B complex, and carnitine, and also a high fat, high protein, low carb diet. I also met with the endocrinologist and he said that I have a mild case of Graves disease hyperthyroid. The medicine for it is toxic, they won't treat it unless it gets severe. I also found out that Graves disease hyperthyroid is usually temporary and that it either will go back to normal or it will get too low."
